

Assistive Technology for Deaf-Blindness

Individuals with deaf-blindness have both hearing and visual impairments — making it challenging for affected individuals to communicate with each other. However, there is a broad range of hearing and vision aids as well as devices with accessibility features and apps to aid in communication.

MOBILE APPS

- AVA: An instant speech-to-text app that provides 24/7 real-time audio transcription
- Rogervoice: First software that can live subtitle all phone conversations in more than 80 languages
- · Sound Amplifier: Improves audio quality by enhancing and amplifying sounds from the real world
- Subtitle Viewer: Synchronizes with television or movies to display subtitles in real time
- ntouch: Mobile sign language communication with the best possible video relay service (VRS)
- Wavello: Video chat app for the hearing to communicate with those who are deaf
- QR & Barcode Scanner: Quickly captures the product bar and verbally announces information
- · Color Blind Pal: Allows those with color blindness or color deficiency to see colors more clearly
- EyeNote: Recognizes U.S. paper currency and communicates verbally back to the user
- BuzzCards: Helps people who are deaf communicate easily with those who don't know sign language
- Seeing Al/Lookout: Uses computer vision to assist people with low vision or blindness
- Be My Eyes: Connects people needing sighted support with a global community of helpers
